

Establishing Educational Guidelines

To facilitate this training, and to institute more republican norms, I would like to put forward the following motion:

1. That the Central Committee, or a delegated body, make a recommended reading list broken up into several groupings:

- Political Economy
- History
- Administration and Management
- Organizing Efforts
- Military Strategy

These lists should put an emphasis on accessibility and readability with the potential of splitting into a beginner/intermediate/advanced lists for each. These lists should be compiled within six months of the finish of the convention.

There is an accompanying motion that is motivated by the same thought process, "For Republican Norms" but is separate from it.
