

For Republican Norms

Every cook can govern - but not every cook is able to, at this moment, be a proficient administrator, let alone one capable of planning and strategizing to build a socialist movement. In order to do this, all members of the working class must be both trained in and have experience with these tasks. To facilitate this training, and to institute more republican norms, I would like to put forward the following motion:

1. That, in the Red Party constitution in Article III Section 9, a subsection be inserted:
 - “Members of the Central Committee are subject to a term limit of two consecutive terms. After a break of at least one full Central Committee term the member may be re-elected or appointed to the Central Committee.”

The change to the Party constitution would not apply retroactively to members of the current Central Committee; only terms following the dissolution of the current Central Committee would be affected.

This motion accompanies the motion titled “Establishing Educational Guides” but is separate from it.
