

For the General Election of the Secretary of the Central Committee

We propose the constitution of the Red Party, Article 3, Section 9, be amended to read that the General Secretary of the Central Committee not be voted on by the smallest unit within the party, the Central Secretary, but by the entire party from the ranks of the Central Committee as voted by the party as well.

Rationale: While we are currently a small party, our chief executive figure should be subject to same level of democratic legitimacy we demand by abolishing the special executive in the polity. Without such measures, the power within the Central Committee can only be checked by recall.
